<u>Town of Pomona Park – Town Council Meeting Minutes</u>

Tuesday, November 9, 12, 2021 (6:00 pm) This Meeting was held at Town Hall for Council & Public VIA TELECONFERENCE. Call 1-888-204-5987 Access Code is 3674654#

Mayor Joseph Svingala presided. Present Councilwoman CarrieAnn Evans, Councilwoman Lynda Linkswiler, Councilwoman Pat Mead, Councilman Victor Szatkowski, Councilman Bud Eckels, Councilman Dr. Warren, Town Clerk Andrea Almeida, Deputy Clerk Kelly Krupski(attended by phone), Bruce Wolfred Maintenance Supervisor.

Mayor Joseph Svingala led in the pledge to the flag. The Meeting started at 6:00 p.m.

Town Clerk Andrea read the Correspondence list.

<u>Minutes of Council Meeting</u>: Councilwoman Evans motioned to approve meeting minutes 10/12/2021. Dr. Warren 2nd the motion. The vote was unanimous.

<u>Unfinished Business</u>: Treasurer Kelly Krupski gave a review of the financials. No questions were asked about financials.

Councilwoman Linkswiler gave a review on Beautification. Mayor Joe, Joey, and Tom planted three hundred twenty new flowers at the post office, bought at cost from Hills Hardware. On November 20 at noon, Beautification is meeting at the Community Center to decorate the Christmas Tree. The Everybody's Yard sale has been rescheduled for December 4. Councilwoman Evans made the motion to approve payment of two Deputies for the yard sale. Councilman Szatkowski 2nd the motion. The Vote was unanimous. The next Beautification meeting will be held on December 6. No breakfast will be held on the day of the Yard Sale.

A discussion was had on Perry Street Drainage. Resident Larry Flayman, address 204 Perry St, stated he was uncomfortable signing the easement letter. My Flayman gave suggestions on how he believed the issues might be resolved. He would like to have the culvert dug out and drop it down farther. The Town Attorney stated that the Town needs to be careful providing services on residents' property. It has been suggested that Councilman Eckels go back and complete a full scope of the project before moving forward any further with the drainage issues.

Guest Speaker- Debbie Harrell from the Property Appraisers office spoke on the ad valorem for seniors. A change to the ordinance, Seniors had to qualify every to be eligible for a tax break on property taxes. Now the only change is if a senior's income changes.

Councilwoman Evans made a motion to adopt ORDINANCE 2021-6

was unanimous.

Russell Corby from Security Lines has presented a demonstration on the Security Lines Us system. He explained how this system holds all the data information inside. Also that this system does not rely on a wireless signal to record. His presentation showed the distance and the options of adding additional cameras at different locations within a mile if clear. Mr. Corby explained that he would take it back if the Town were unhappy with the system's purchase.

New Business

Councilman Eckels would like for the Town to move forward on getting the Community Center steps replaced. Maintenance Supervisor Bruce stated that he requested wider pads to be put in so that the steps would be more manageable for people to use. The estimate that we have received does not cover the cost of the railing. Depending on the type, it will be around \$1,200 to \$1,500 to replace. Councilman Eckels made a motion to spend up to the max of \$5,000 for repairs of the Community Center Steps and railing. Councilwoman Linkswiler 2nd the motion. The Vote was unanimous.

Mayor Svingala has invited the Council to the Maintenance Building on Saturday, November 13, to recognize all that the staff has accomplished. Mayor Svingala would like to change Bruce's title from Supervisor to Superintendent of Public Works. Councilwoman Mead made a motion to change Bruce's title from Supervisor to Superintendent of Public Works. Councilwoman Evans 2nd the motion. The Vote was unanimous.

A discussion was had about zoning and animals in the Town of Pomona Park. Per the Town Attorney Craig, the Town does not have anything against horses as Pets. Councilman Szatkowski explained the definition listed from the Florida State Statues of what a livestock animal is defined and domestic animals. The Town Attorney stated that our code does not specify a pet and what can be a pet. Craig suggests that the Council adopt a new ordinance stating how many animals and what kind are allowed. Mayor Svingala suggested the Council hold a workshop.

Upcoming events were reviewed, chat with the Mayor will be Saturday from 7-9 am.

Councilwoman Evans motioned to adjourn.

ORDINANCE 2021-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF POMONA PARK, FLORIDA, GRANTING ADDITIONAL HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION FOR LOW-INCOME SENIORS, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.



WHEREAS, the voters of the State of Florida have passed Amendment 11 – Additional Homestead Exemption for Low-Income Seniors; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined they desire to grant an additional exemption allowed by Amendment 11,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF POMONA PARK: Section 1.

Chapter 46 of the Town of Pomona Park Code of Ordinances is amended as follows. Add section 46-25, which shall read as follows:

An additional exemption is granted from ad valorem real property taxes in an amount equal to the assessed value of the property where: a) the property is the owners homestead, b) the just value of the property is less than \$250,000, c) the owner has maintained permanent residence on the property for not less than 25 years, d) the owners are 65 years old or older and, e) the household income does not exceed the household income limitation set out in Florida Statute § 196.075.

This exemption only applies to taxes levied by the Town of Pomona Park.

The taxpayer must claim the exemption annually. The application shall be submitted to the property appraiser of Putnam County by March 1 of each the application year.

Pursuant to amendment 11, a supermajority is required for passage

Section 2. Severability

Each phrase, sentence, paragraph, section or other provision of this Ordinance is severable from all other such phrases, sentences, paragraphs, sections and provisions. Should any phrase, sentence, paragraph, section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such declaration shall not affect any other portion or provision of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Conflicts

All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby superseded or repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage as provided by law and shall apply to the ad valorem taxes from January 1, 2022, and thereafter.
