WHEREAS, the Town of Pomona Park of Putnam County, Florida on September 9, 2020, adopted Fiscal Year Tentative Millage Rates following a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Pomona Park of Putnam County, Florida on September 21, 2020, held a final public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065 to adopt final levying of ad valorem taxes for Pomona Park for 2020-2021; and,

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Pomona Park has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the Town of Pomona Park as \$32,906,176.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF POMONA PARK, PUTNAM COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

- 1. The Fiscal Year 2020-2021 operating millage rate is 5.2974 which is the rolled-back rate.
- 2. The voted debt service millage is zero.
